

Kansas Barber Practical Examination Procedures – 2.5 Hours

TAPER HAIRCUT MODEL Must be a live model with a **minimum** of ½ inch of hair at the nape and 2+ inches on top **and** at least 1 day of beard growth prior to beginning examination.

1. Shave.
2. Facial Massage - Effleurage (eye orbits), Petrissage (cheeks), Tapotement (chin/jaw area)
3. Tapered Haircut.

4. Scalp Manipulations.
5. Shampoo & Style.

CALL CHECK.

LAYERED HAIRCUT MODEL OR MANNEQUIN Must have a **minimum of 4"** of hair all over AFTER the haircut is finished. Allow sufficient length to perform remaining services.

1. Layered Haircut. Must be a 90° elevation haircut (this is known as the 90° angle cut per the Pivot Point textbook, or the uniformed layered cut per the Milady textbook).

2. Section front half of hair from ear to ear. Front section will be divided into three (3) sub-sections. Top center will be appropriate for rolling perm rods. Each side will be used for haircolor techniques. *See image for example.*



PERMANENT WAVE WRAPPING TECHNIQUES

3. Perform the following procedures in their designated sections. (*See diagram*)

Section 1 (middle) – Conventional Wrap – Three (3) perm rods (1 on-base, 1 half-off base, and 1 off-base).

HAIRCOLOR APPLICATION TECHNIQUES

Color applications will be simulated using Cholesterol or similar consistency product.

4. Perform the following procedures in their designated sections. (*See diagram*)

Section 2 (left) – Virgin Application (Must be performed on entire sub-section)

Section 3 (right) – Retouch 2" growth (Must be performed on entire sub-section)
