

IMPORTANT: Prior to the examination date, you must have your lesson plan prepared. Remember to bring 4 copies (one for each of the examiners).

The **Written** portion of the Instructor Exam will consist of:

A 25-question test over the Kansas Rules and Regulations. (25 points)

Provide 4 typed copies of a lesson plan covering all procedures that are being demonstrated. (25 points)

250-word essays over 2 of the following subjects. Subjects will be chosen on the day of the exam. (50 points - 25 points each)

1. Recognizing all hair types (oily, normal, dry, etc.) and their recommended treatments.
2. Hair coloring.
3. Why you want to be an instructor and your opinion of what is important to teach.
4. Sanitation and disinfection relating to public health and the client's welfare.
5. Hair cutting techniques (including razor; clippers; shear and comb; etc.); their applications and purposes. Explain in full each technique.
6. Restructuring hair through permanent waving / relaxing and how it works chemically.
7. Shaving (draping and procedure).

You will have 1 hour and 30 minutes to complete the written portion of the exam.

A minimum overall score of 75% is required to pass the instructor's examination.
